Job Summary

Flatwater North is Whitehorse's sprint-canoe kayak club (CKC). We are situated on the shore of the pristine Schwatka Lake, just three km from downtown Whitehorse. Since its beginning in 2013, the CKC has grown rapidly and created a great community of young paddlers. The CKC has a core group of 12–17-year-old athletes, who are dedicated to paddling: they participate in a full-day training program at the club. The CKC has the potential to create high level athletes for the sport and becoming one of the strongest sport clubs in the Yukon.

Our organization is seeking a Competitive Coach who would be willing to stay long-term. With plans to send athletes to the upcoming Canada Summer Games, our need is pressing. We want to raise the capacity of the competitive program in order to have a full team at the 2025 Canada Summer Games.

The main focus for the Coach is to build a culture of personal excellence and guide these athletes towards competition. We are seeking a skilled, enthusiastic and self-motivated coach to guide our competitive athletes through the *Training to Train* and *Learning to Compete* stages of CKC the Long-Term Athlete Development framework.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Develop athletes (overall fitness, technique, performance, and level of competitiveness)
- Create and oversee the implementation of the Competitive Sprint Team Program for athletes at the *Training to Train* and *Learning to Compete* stages on LTAD framework
- Develop year-round training programs for athletes
- Ensure the safety and well-being of all participants
- Oversee school day programs (Introduction to paddling)
- Work with Executive Director to coordinate travel, registration and logistics for all regattas
- Be a model /mentor for staff
- Implement all club rules and policies, including athlete code of conduct
- Contribute to monthly and annual program review and strategic planning with the board of directors
- Participate in spring recruitment at local schools
- Act as primary parent liaison for competitive athletes

• Perform ongoing minor equipment maintenance, and make recommendations to the board for major maintenance and new equipment procurement
